




Figure:1 Resource Person demonstrating Teaching Learning Techniques











Figure:2 Resource Person demonstrating Practical Teaching techniques



Objective of the Meeting:

The meeting was convened to discuss about the Modification of Syllabus of Existing Courses for B.Ed to meet the requirements of current scenario in the teacher education domain and syllabus is upgraded with purview of students centric and as per the guidelines of NCTE. (While revising the Curriculum and Syllabus the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Elective Course System (ECS) were followed besides considering the aspects mentioned below.)

- To develop the curriculum based on Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework(LOCF)
- To implement the guidelines and suggestions of the new education policy while preparing the curriculum.
- To design the curriculum focusing on the development of the creative potential that
 will shape the next generation grounded in Indian values, languages, knowledge, ethos, and
 traditions while also being well-versed in the latest advances in education and pedagogy.
- To bring uniform allocation of marks in all the theory papers into hundred marks course.
- To reduce existing marks for the B.Ed Programme 3300 (Theory 1500+ Task & Assignment 300+ Practicum1500) to 2200 (theory 1500 and Practicum700).
- To modify the credits allocated in the two year programme for B.Ed under regulation 2016 to 80 credits (Theory 60 and Practicum 20) from 104 credits as per NEP 2020.
- To introduce new courses namely
 - 1. Understanding the Discipline and School subjects
 - 2.Language across the curriculum.
- To modify and revise the syllabus by 50%.

Feedback from Academic Experts and Educational Officer:

The following suggestions given by the Academic Experts and Educational Officer were also taken into consideration while revising the syllabus.

- The practical assessment which was conducted at the end of the second and fourth semester can be combined and be conducted once in the fourth semester before the theory exams.
- To give credit transfer to equivalent courses in Swayam and MOOC.
- To retain Peace and Value education as insisted by WHO.
- To alter the Question paper pattern into ten questions carrying three marks and five questions carrying eight marks and two questions carrying fifteen marks in either or pattern.
- Resolved that the existing syllabus have been revised in the courses for the development of student teachers to gain adequate knowledge, skill, disposition and values
- Resolved and approved to bring all the theory papers into hundred marks course.
- Resolved that the existing marks for the B.Ed Programme 3300 (Theory 1500+ Task & Assignment 300+ Practicum1500) is reduced to 2200 (theory 1500 and Practicum700) as per the guidelines of NCTE and to be at par with Central and State Universities.
- Resolved that the existing credits of two year programme for B.Ed under regulation 2016 can be reduced from 104 credits to 80 credits (Theory 60 and Practicum 20) at par with contemporary Universities. (Central and State).
- Resolved and approved to introduce two new courses namely
 - 1. Understanding the Discipline and School subjects
 - 2. Language across the curriculum.
- Resolved the modified titles are approved as it is as per the guidelines of NCTE and NCERT.
- Resolved to retain Peace and Value Education course as it is essential for teacher trainees.

After discussion the members have unanimously approved the revised syllabus and also recommended to place it before the Academic Council for its approval.
