Specific facilities provided for women in terms of

a) Safety and Security:

- Well trained in-house Male & female security staff are posted in different locations to provide safety to all staff and students within the campus. Thus the campus is blessed with 24 x 7 security services.
- An extensive electronic surveillance conducted to using CCTV cameras throughout the campus to prevent acts of harassment / violence against women as well as others.
- Prominent Helpline posters are displayed throughout the campus for emergency.
- Proper medical assistance is instantly provided for students inside VISTAS premises.
- Free ambulance services are available for any emergencies.
- VISTAS conducts gender specific medical camps like antenatal camp, anaemia screening, cervical screening, breast cancer screening etc.,

• Women safety Mobile APP (Kavalan SOS) introduced for all our girl students and women faculty members to get instant assistance in case of emergency.

• Separate hostels for men and women with experienced inhouse wardens (male and female) are available

• Sanitary vending and incinerating machine are available to maintain menstrual hygiene.

b) Counselling:

The mentoring system has been adopted to improve the rapport between the faculty members and students. The main objective of the counselling is to keep track students' progress and counsel them accordingly for academic and personal guidance.

VISTAS had appointed professional female counsellor for providing counselling services to all the girl students and women employees within the campus.

c) Common Room:

Exclusive common room facilities with recreation amenities are provided for boys and girls, attached toilet and beds in each of the schools.

d) Day care centre for young children:

Day care crèche facilities are being provided for the staff children from 8:00 am- 6:00 pm at our campus. The staffs present in the day care crèche takes good care of the children and young teachers being mother can render their service peacefully during their working hours.

e) Any other relevant information:

VISTAS had its own policy for gender sensitization and also perform regular gender related audits.

VISTAS offers gender related subjects in certain programs to help the students understand the concept of social justice and gender justice.

VISTAS provide exclusive gym and indoor sports facilities for women.










ANY OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION (AMBULANCE SERVICES)




