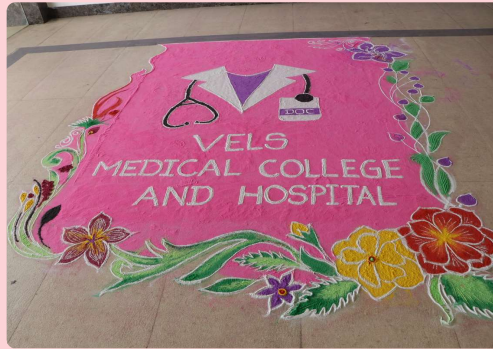
FRESHERS DAY 2024

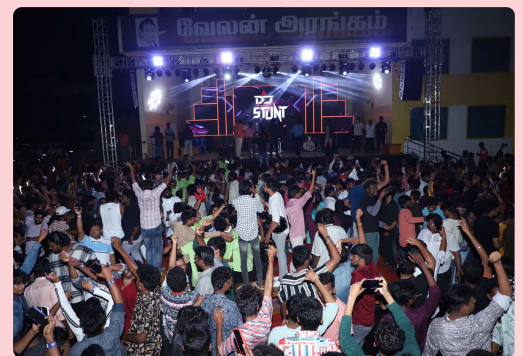
CADET CEREMONY

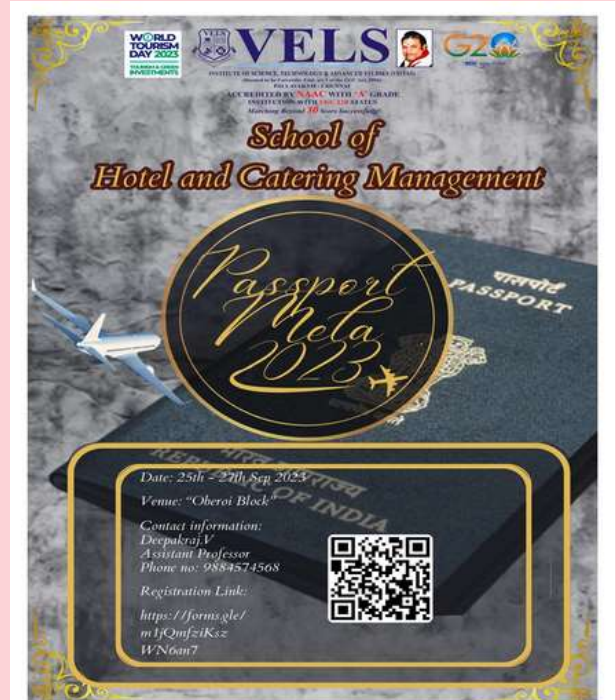
VELS FAMILY DAY
