VELS INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND ADVANCED STUDIES (VISTAS) has been established in the year 2008 under section 3 of the Act of 1956 of University Grants Commission, Government of India, New Delhi. VISTAS has originated from a self-financing Group of Institutions known as Vels Group of Institutions established in 1992. The Head Office of the VISTAS is located at Pallavaram around 2 kms. south of Pallavaram railway station and nearly 4 kms away from Chennai Airport. The Deemed University status has been conferred by UGC after taking into account the rich experience accumulated by the Management and quality maintained in the field of Higher education.

VISTAS has blossomed into a multi-disciplinary Institute offering more than 100 UG & PG programs, besides Doctoral programs, through 16 Schools and 45 Departments. Programs have the approval of the relevant Statutory Regulating Agencies such as UGC, AICTE, PCI, BCI, NCTE, DGS etc. VISTAS has a student strength close to 11913 and faculty strength close to 696 with 348 of them having doctorate degree. The School of Maritime Studies was awarded “A1” grade by the Indian Register of Shipping (IRS) in Nov-2016. VISTAS has been accredited by NAAC with a CGPA of 3.01 / 4 (A) grade in March 2019. B.E., Mechanical Engineering, B.E., Computer Science & Engineering, Master of Business Administration, B.Pharmacy and B.E., Marine Engineering programmes have been accredited by the NBA.



VISTAS is included in the list of Deemed to be Universities under section of 12B of the UGC Act, 1956 on Nov'2021. VISTAS is also recognized as a Scientific and Industrial Research Organization (SIRO) by the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. VISTAS has improved infrastructure, modernized laboratories, increased the hostel accommodation and improved sports facilities. Since becoming deemed university, syllabi has been revamped periodically in all disciplines. There has been a significant increase in the enrolment of students and more so among women students. The Deemed University is well equipped with ICT facilities such as Smart class rooms, Video Conferencing, Online courses and Vels Knowledge Resource Centre. VISTAS has Centre for Fish Immunology, Incubation Centre, Central Instrumentation Laboratory, Centre for Energy and Alternative Fuels, Centre for Artificial Intelligence, Centre for Automation and Power Conservation, Centre for Material Research, Centre for Excellence in Pharmaceutical Research & Drug Testing, Centre for Elephant Research, Centre for Bioengineering, Centre of Excellence in Cloud Computing with IBM, Centre of Excellence in Business Analytics with IBM, Centre for Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), Centre for Advanced Research & Development (CARD), Centre for Multimedia Research, Centre for Transfer of Technology, Centre of Excellence in Constitutional Law and Centre of Excellence in MAT Lab.

The institution has continued to demonstrate commendable achievements across various spheres. It has conducted 20 workshops/seminars,

published/awarded 95 patents & copyrights, and engaged in 9 consultancy projects. Notably, it received 81.40 lakhs in seed funding and established 38 Memoranda of Understanding, indicating robust partnerships and resource acquisition efforts. The active participation of students in 79 sports and cultural activities reflects a vibrant campus culture. Moreover, 271 teachers have been recognized with national/international fellowships or financial support for advanced studies and collaborative research, indicating a commitment to faculty development.

With a pass percentage of 91.22, where 3667 students out of 4020 passed, the institution continues to uphold academic standards and support student success. As it graduates 4249 students and receives 116 awards for innovation/discoveries, it underscores its dedication to nurturing talent and fostering innovation. Additionally, the publication of 1197 indexed works across prestigious platforms such as Scopus, WoS, PubMed, and UGC demonstrates a commitment to contributing to the scholarly community and advancing knowledge.
