VELS INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND ADVANCED STUDIES (VISTAS) has been established in the year 2008 under section 3 of the Act of 1956 of University Grants Commission, Government of India, New Delhi. VISTAS has originated from a self-financing Group of Institutions known as Vels Group of Institutions established in 1992. The Head Office of the VISTAS is located at Pallavaram around 2 kms. south of Pallavaram railway station and nearly 4 kms away from Chennai Airport. The Deemed University status has been conferred by UGC after taking into account the rich experience accumulated by the Management and quality maintained in the field of Higher education.

VISTAS has blossomed into a multi-disciplinary Institute offering more than 100 UG & PG programs, besides Doctoral programs, through 18 Schools and 47 Departments. Programs have the approval of the relevant Statutory Regulating Agencies such as UGC, AICTE, PCI, BCI, NCTE, DGS etc. The institution at present, has about 13,235 students and 742 faculty members with 385 of them having doctorate degree. The School of Maritime Studies was awarded “A1” grade by the Indian Register of Shipping (IRS) in Nov-2022. VISTAS has been accredited by NAAC with a CGPA of 3.01 / 4 (A) grade in March 2019. B.E., Mechanical Engineering, B.E., Computer Science & Engineering, Master of Business Administration, B.Pharmacy B.E., Marine Engineering, B.E., Electronics & Communication Engineering, B.E., Electrical and Electronics Engineering, B.Tech.IT(Cloud and Mobile



Application Development) and B.E., Biomedical Engineering programmes have been accredited by the NBA. Pharmacy is in 47th Rank, Engineering in 101-150 Band and the University is in 101-150 Band in the NIRF Ranking 2023. VISTAS has been placed in NIRF Innovation (Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements) Ranking in 51-100 Band.

VISTAS has been accorded with 12B status by UGC. VISTAS is also recognized as a Scientific and Industrial Research Organization (SIRO) by the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. VISTAS has improved infrastructure, modernized laboratories, increased the hostel accommodation and improved sports facilities. Since becoming deemed university, syllabi has been revamped periodically in all disciplines. There has been a significant increase in the enrolment of students especially women students. The institution is well equipped with ICT facilities such as Smart class rooms, Video Conferencing, Online courses and Vels Knowledge Resource Centre.

VISTAS has number of Advanced Research Centres to support the research activities in various departments such as, Centre for Fish Immunology, Centre for Energy and Alternative Fuels, Centre for Artificial Intelligence, Centre for Automation and Power Conservation, Centre for Material Research, Centre for Excellence in Pharmaceutical Research & Drug Testing, Centre for Elephant Research, Centre of Excellence in Cloud Computing with IBM, Centre of Excellence in Business Analytics with IBM, Centre for Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), Centre for Advanced Research



& Development (CARD), Centre for Multimedia Research, Centre for Transfer of Technology and Centre of Excellence in Constitutional Law. Also, nearly 100 leading industries are associating with VISTAS and has a very strong Industry Institution Interface.

VISTAS has a well-established Central Instrumentation Research Laboratory with state-of-the-art facilities with a worth of 11.2 Crores and vibrant Incubation Centre in its campus where the industries are busy in developing products useful to the society.

The VISTAS Library houses a collection of 1,41,320 books, 1,96,898 e-books and 13,897 back volumes. More than 374 periodicals (National and International) 12,535 e-journals have been subscribed. It has about 4,961 dissertations and 5,317 Audio-Video Resources.

The University periodically gets students feedback, self-appraisal report from staff and also conducts Academic Audit through Internal Quality Assurance System. VISTAS has a vibrant Entrepreneurial Development Cell, Career Development, Placement and Training to look after the placement of the students. Thus, the Institute fulfills its mission of carrying education to hitherto neglected marginalized section so as to provide social justice and participate in the strategy of inclusive growth in education.
